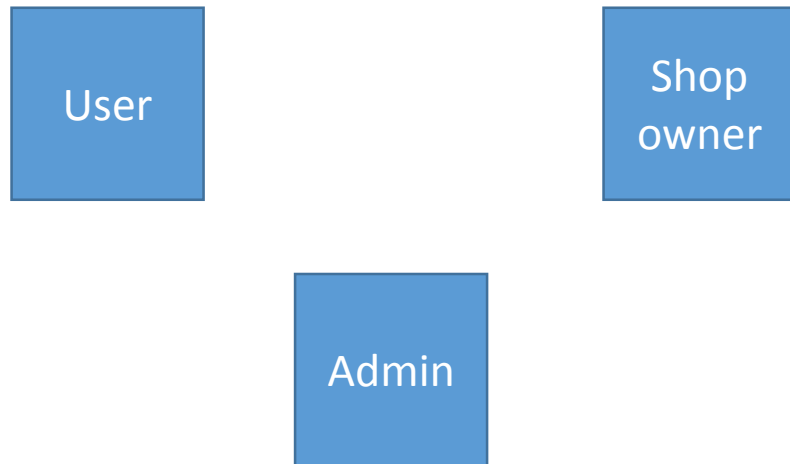


# There are 3 roles:

- User: who uses app to browse shops and buy products
- Shop owner: who uses backend to create shops & products
- Admin: who can manage everything of the system



# Shop owner's Balance (virtual wallet)

- Each Shop owner has a balance, where he can deposit real money to or withdraw (payout request) real money from

# User buys products via paypal

- When User buys products of a Shop owner via paypal.
- The real money will go to Admin's paypal account
- The virtual value will be added to the Shop owner's balance
- Every month, the Shop owner can make Payout request to withdraw to real money from his balance. At that time, Admin has to send the real money to the Shop owner manually. The Admin will keep his commission

# Admin can configure the financial settings for system

- Commission that Admin can get per orders paid to Shop owner via paypal by the User
- Subscription fee for Premium restaurant owner
- Refund policy
  - The earning is only valid after 15 days
  - Within 15 days, User can make refund request if he does not satisfy with the Shop owner

# Shop owner choose subscription type

- Shop owner can chose subscription type:
  - Free: basic profile
  - Premium: Featured profie
- If Shop owner chooses Premium, his balance will be deducted monthly by subscription fee automatically
  - If his balance is not enough, he will be automatically back to basic profile
- The subscription fee can be set by the Admin
